

VERBS WITH THE ENDING -RE

Example: vend**RE** (to sell)

SINGULAR	PLURAL
Je vend <u>s</u>	Nous vend <u>ons</u>
Tu vend <u>s</u>	Vous vend <u>ez</u>
Il vend	Ils vend <u>ent</u>
Elle vend	Elles vend <u>ent</u>

It means...

I sell

You sell

He, She sells

We sell

You sell

They sell

Before you keep going, you need to know a few things...

*The endings "-s, -d" and "-ons, -ez, -ent" are silent (when you speak).

* "Vend" is the "radical" (stem) of the verb. To conjugate a verb, you take the radical then add the "terminaison" (ending): s, ons, ez, ent.
